RESPONSIBILITIES:

WCCC hosts 4 weeks of Summer Nature Camps for residents of Tewksbury/Oldwick and the greater community. The Head Counselor's primary responsibility will be to assist with the planning and preparation for each camp session in coordination with the Executive Director and lead the day-to-day operations of each camp session, with the assistance of another camp counselor and 3/4 CIT's.

Leading the day-to-day operations will include supervising staff, planning and leading activities, and managing all parent, child, and staff concerns. Each camp week will have its own schedule.
