**Description:** Whittemore is a 180-acre preserve, bequeathed to Tewksbury Township by Helen A. Whittemore, a nature lover and diarist, whose greatest wish was that others be awed by the natural world and inspired to conserve it. The property includes Whittemore House, Meadows and 11 miles of trails that traverse wooded areas with wetlands, ravines and hilly terrain for hiking, dog walking, exploring, photographing, painting nature and the perfect stage for birders and nature lovers to view local avian species and other wildlife.
